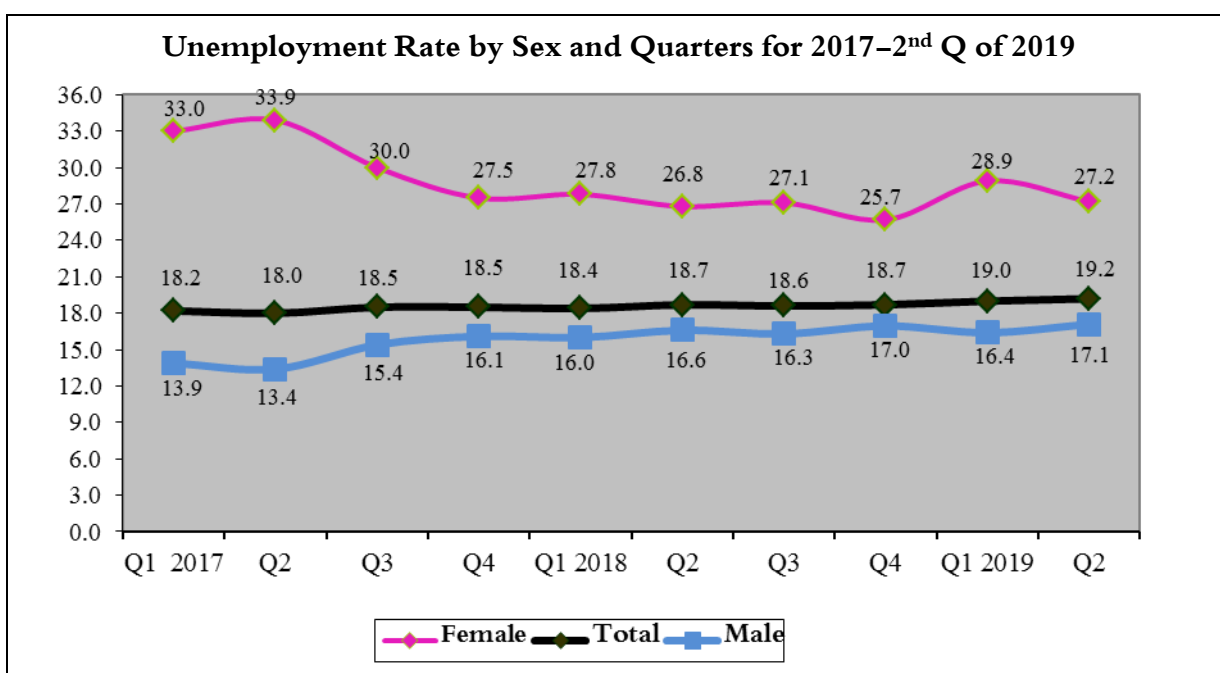


19.2% Unemployment Rate during the second Quarter of 2019

The Department of Statistics issued its quarterly report on the Unemployment Rate in the kingdom for the second quarter of 2019. The following are the main results:

Unemployment:

- ❖ The results show that the Unemployment Rate has reached (19.2%) during the second quarter of 2019 ; representing an increase by 0.5 percentage points of the second quarter of 2018.
- ❖ the Unemployment Rate for males has reached (17.1%) during the second quarter of 2019 against (27.2%) for females .It becomes clear that the Unemployment Rate has increased for males by 0.5 percentage points and for females by 0.4 percentage points compared with the second quarter of 2018.



The Unemployed:

- ❖ The Survey results show that the Unemployment Rate is high among the university degree holders (Bachelor degree and higher divided by labor force for the same educational level) by 25.9% compared with the other educational levels.
- ❖ The results also show that 56.1% of the Unemployed are secondary certificate holders and higher, and that 43.9% have less than secondary school qualifications.
- ❖ Male Unemployed percentage of bachelor holders and higher was 30.1% against 84.7% for females which is varied according to educational level and sex.
- ❖ The highest rate of Unemployment was recorded in the age group 15-19 and 20-24 years by 46.2% and 39.9% respectively.
- ❖ The highest Rate of Unemployment was recorded in Madaba at 25.6% and the lowest rate was recorded in Karak at 14.9%.

The Employed:

- ❖ The Employed rate among the age group (15 and above) is 28.0%.
- ❖ The results show that about 59.2% of the employed males and 63.6% of the employed females are concentrated in the age group 20-39 years.
- ❖ About half of the employed have less than secondary qualifications, 8.3% of the secondary level and 39.6% are higher than secondary level.
- ❖ The results also show that about 85.2% of the employed are paid employees (82.8% for males against 95.8% for females).

The Labor Force: (Employed & Unemployed):

- ❖ The results show a clear variation in the labor force distribution with regard to educational level and sex. It was found that about 60.2% of the total male labor force has less than secondary educational qualifications compared to 12.6% for females. The results indicate also that 69.9% of the total labor force among females has bachelor level or higher, compared with 24.8% for males.
- ❖ The Crude Economic Activity Rate (i.e. labor force attributed to the total population) reached 23.7%.
- ❖ The Refined Economic Participation Rate (the labor force attributed to the population 15 years and over) is 34.6% for the whole Kingdom (53.9% for males against 14.5% for females) for the second quarter of 2019 compared with 35.7% for the whole Kingdom (55.3% for males and 15.3 % for females) for the second quarter of 2018.

It should be noted that the Labor Force Survey with its new methodology included a total sample size of about 16 thousand households distributed all over the governorates of the Kingdom, and it is representative for the Urban, Rural, and Governorates. This Survey are carried out at the middle of every quarter and provide data reflecting the situation of the complete quarter (April, May and June). The individual is asked whether he/she has searched for a job during the last four weeks before the interview according to the international recommendations applied in Jordan.

Annual Unemployment Rate and for the 2nd Quarter of 2007–2019
