





# National exports increase by 40.7% and Imports by 34.0% during the first ten months of 2022 compared with the same period of 2021

The monthly report issued by the Department of Statistics indicate that the value of total exports reached JD.7412.5 million during the first ten months of 2022 [i.e., an increase by 39.1% compared with the same period of 2021]. Meanwhile, the national exports value reached JD.6822.6 Million during the first ten months of 2022 [i.e. an increase by 40.7% compared with the same period of 2021]. The value of re-exports reached JD 589.9 million during the first ten months of 2022 which indicates an increase by 22.1% as compared with the same period of 2021. The imports value reached JD.16541.6 million during the first ten months of 2022, thus an increasing by 34.0% compared with the same period of 2021.

The deficit in the trade balance has reached JD.9129.1 million therefore; the deficit has increased during the first ten months of 2022 by 30.2% compared with the same period of 2021.



On monthly level the value of total exports reached JD.690.2 million during October 2022 [i.e., an increase by 12.9% compared with the same period of 2021]. Meanwhile, the national exports value reached JD.631.1 Million during October 2022 [i.e. an increase by 11.8% compared with the same period of 2021]. The value of re-exports reached JD 59.1 million during October 2022 which indicates an increase by 26.6% as compared with the same period of 2021. The imports value reached JD.1704.4 million October 2022, thus increasing by 13.9% compared with the same period of 2021.

Hence the trade deficit has reached 1014.2 Million dinar which means an increase by 14.6% during October 2022 as compared with the same month of 2021.
