13.97% the average increase of the producer's prices index for 2022 compared with 2021

The monthly report issued by the Department of Statistics indicates an increase in the producer's prices index for 2022 to reach 141.72 against 124.34 for the same period of 2021 recording an increase by 13.97%. This mainly was a result of an increase in the index number of the prices of the manufacturing Industries by 13.90 % with a relative importance of 86.01% and the index number of the prices of the quarrying industries by 34.17 % with a relative importance of 8.22%.

Meanwhile, there was a decrease in the index number of the prices of electricity by 7.75 % with a relative importance of 5.76%.

The report also indicates an increase in the industrial producer's index number in December 2022 to reach 139.48 against 132.32 for the same month of 2021 to record an increase by 5.41%. This mainly has resulted from an increase in the index number of the prices of manufacturing Industries by 4.41 % with a relative importance of 86.01% and the prices of quarrying production by 28.55 % with a relative importance of 8.22%. Meanwhile there was a decrease in the index number of the prices of the electricity by 8.47 % with a relative importance of 5.76%.
