## **1.61% the Average increase of the General Consumer Price Index for November 2021 compared with the same month of 2020 (100=2018)**

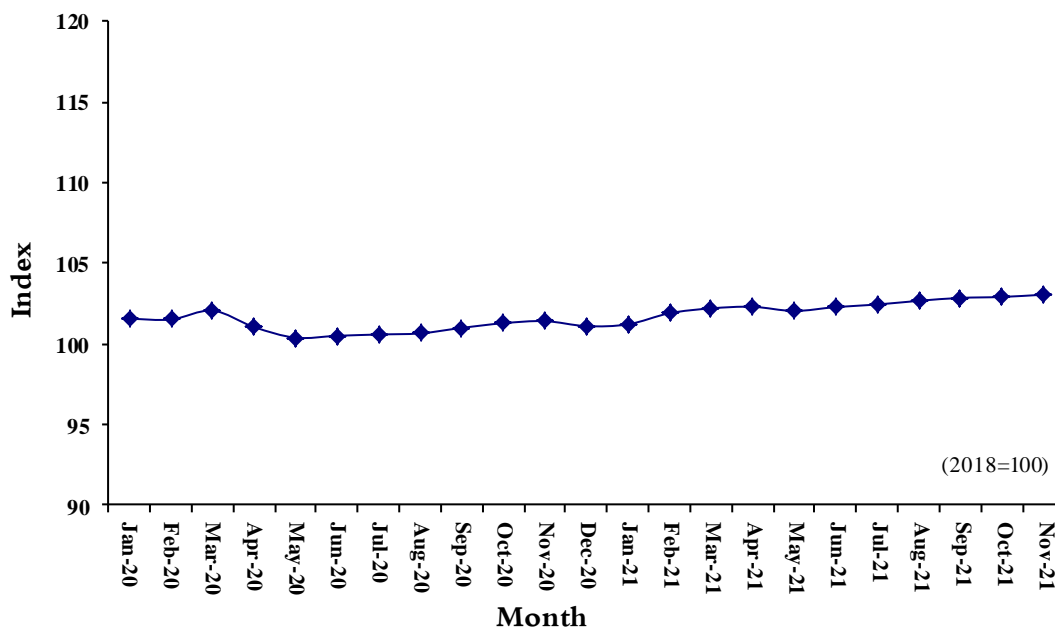
The monthly report on the Consumer Price Index in Jordan issued by the Department of Statistics indicates that the Consumer Price Average reached 103.06 in November 2021 against 101.42 during the same month of 2020 recording an increase by 1.61%. The main commodities groups, which contributed to this increase, were “Transport” by 1.00 percentage points, “Meat & poultry” by 0.39 percentage points, “Fuel & lighting” by 0.24 percentage points and “Culture & Recreation” by 0.13 percentage point. Meanwhile, the main commodities groups which witnessed a decrease in their prices were “Vegetables, Dried and Canned Legumes” by 0.65 percentage points and, “Health” by 0.08 percentage point, “Dairy and its products and eggs” by 0.05 percentage points, and “Fruits & Nuts” by 0.04 percentage points.

On the monthly level, the Consumer Price index for November 2021 reached 103.06 against 102.92 during the previous month of 2021 recording an increase by 0.13%. The main commodities groups which contributed to this increase were “Culture & Recreation” by 0.08 percentage point, “Fruits & Nuts” by 0.04 percentage points, “Meat & poultry” by 0.03 percentage points, “Transport” by 0.02 percentage points, and “Health” by 0.02 percentage points. Meanwhile, the main commodities groups witnessed a decrease in their prices were “Vegetables, Dried and Canned Legumes” by 0.11 percentage points and “Beverages” by 0.01 percentage point.

The report also shows that the Consumer Price index for the eleven months of 2021 reached 102.36 against 101.10 during the same period of 2020 recording an increase by 1.25%. The main commodities groups which contributed to this increase were transport” by 0.66 percentage points, “Meat & poultry” by 0.28 percentage points, “Tobacco and Cigarettes” by 0.12 percentage points, and “Oil & fats” by 0.10 percentage points. Meanwhile, the main commodities groups which witnessed a decrease in their prices were “Fruits &Nuts” by 0.06 percentage points, “clothes” by 0.04 percentage points, and “spices and other food flavorings” by 0.02 percentage points.

As for the core consumer Price index for November 2021 (which is calculated after excluding the most fluctuating commodities’ prices of food, fuel, lighting and transport group) it has reached 69.30 against 68.56 recording an increase of 1.07% during the same month of 2020. On the accumulative level the core consumer price index for the first eleven months of 2021 reached 69.03 against 68.41 compared with 202 representing an increase by 0.91%.
